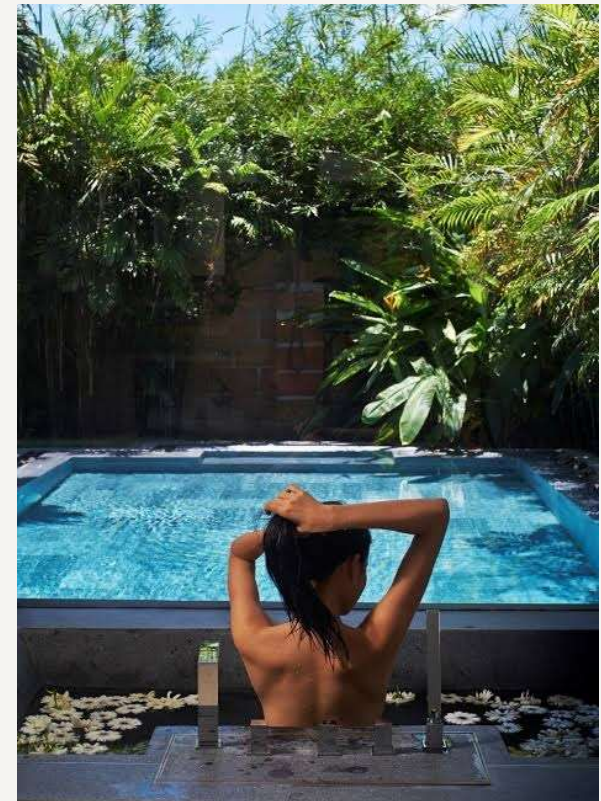


A wellness destination

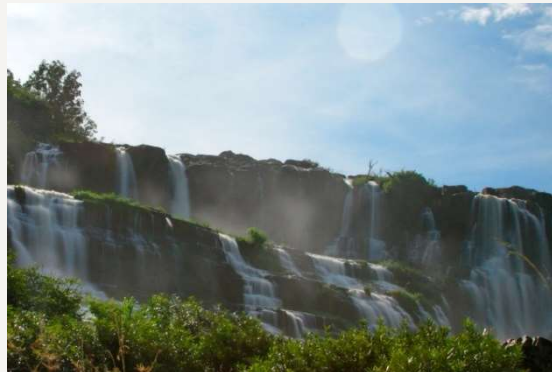


Dalat Spring City – Buon Ma Thuot - Pleiku

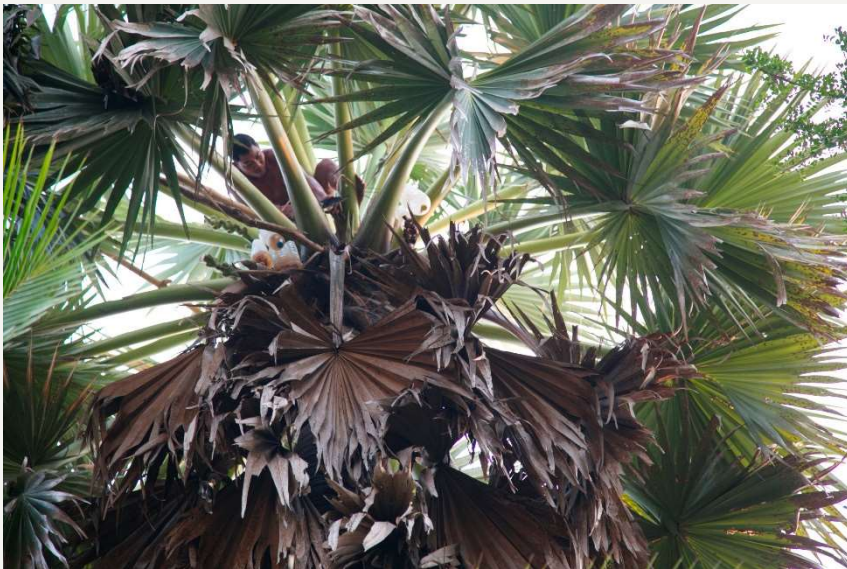
